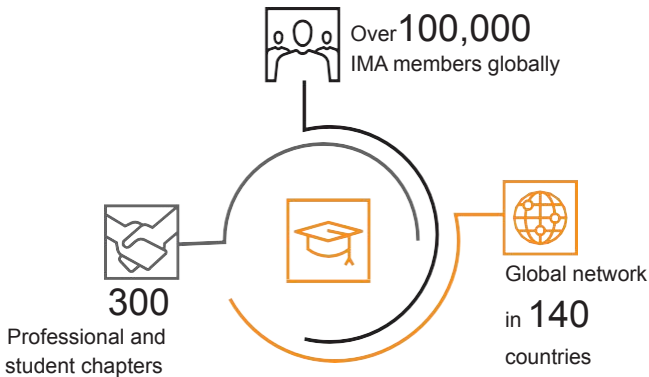
About the CMA

For over 40 years the Certified Management Accountant (CMA) designation from the Institute of Management Accountants (IMA) has served as the benchmark for excellence in the field of management accounting.

Achieving the CMA demonstrates your professional expertise in financial planning, analysis, control, decision support, and professional ethics- skills that are in demand by organisations around the world.

Whether you want to enhance the value you bring to your current position, or expand your career potential, the CMA will help you set the standard for professional excellence.

The CMA is the gold standard for those in the profession. It requires the mastery of the skills and concepts necessary for management accountants. Employers seek out those who have earned the designation as it provides assurance of the proficiencies required for excellence in management accounting.



Getting qualified

To get your CMA certification, you must meet the eligibility requirements which include passing 2 exams, Part 1 and Part 2, holding a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, and completing two continuous years of professional experience in management accounting. This requirement may be completed prior to, during or within seven years of passing the exams.

- The CMA exam consists of two parts, each of which is a four hour examination
- The exams consists of 100 MCQs and two essay style questions
- There are three exam windows. Each of these are on-demand computer based
- The exams can be taken in Jan/Feb, May/ June, and Sept/Oct
- The minimum passing score is 360 out of 500 for each part

How long does it take?

The CMA programme lets you proceed at your own pace. As there are only two exams it is possible to complete your CMA in 6-12 months.
